

**The Meier PMRC Travel Inclusion Awards
2023 Public Management Research Conference, Utrecht**

The Meier PMRC Travel Inclusion Award provides financial support to doctoral students who expand the diversity of participants at the conference. To be eligible for the award, students must be presenting a paper or poster at the conference. Awards will be a minimum of \$500 US.

The Award prioritizes supporting American students who identify as African American, Hispanic or Latina/o, Native American, Asian-American, or Pacific Islanders, or as LGBTQ+. Applications from doctoral students of any nationality who expand the representation of conference participants, and from students for whom participation in the conference would represent a financial hardship, are also welcomed.

Application Instructions

Please submit the following in one merged file:

1. A cover letter that includes the following:
 - a. Title of accepted paper and list of co-authors (if any).
 - b. A clear description of how you meet one or more of the selection criteria.
 - c. An explanation of whether you will receive supplemental funds or grants from your university for the conference, and if yes, approximately how much funding you may receive.
 - d. A statement about whether you currently are a PMRA member or if you will become a member by the time of the conference.
2. A brief letter from your PhD supervisor or PhD program director indicating (1) whether they support you presenting your work at the conference, and (2) the level of financial support you are likely to receive from your department, if any. This does not need to be a long, detailed letter. A letter with a few sentences will be adequate.
3. A current CV
