The Public Administration Theory Network seeks a new editor-in-chief for its journal, *Administrative Theory and Praxis* (ATP) to start January 1, 2024.

A Taylor and Francis journal, ATP has been published since 1977 is a leading quarterly journal for critical, normative, or interpretive scholarship focused on various aspects of public administration theory, governance, and management. ATP is published quarterly and offers a unique forum to contest or affirm public administration orthodoxies, advance alternative approaches to administrative theory and practice, and examine ethical, democratic, and social justice issues in the field. ATP accepts traditional article-length manuscripts, shorter dialogue pieces, and book reviews. ATP also provides a venue for symposia on boundary-spanning and boundary challenging or breaking topics. ATP is currently listed in SCOPUS with a 2021 Cite Score of 2.9.

The Search Committee seeks an editor or editors with a national reputation for thoughtful theoretical contributions to the discipline of public administration. Nominations or expressions of interest should be directed to the chair of the search committee. Applications for the position should include a statement of vision and editorial goals for the journal, a letter of institutional support, and a Curriculum Vitae. To receive full consideration, completed applications should be submitted to the chair of the search committee by **April 15, 2023**. The new editorial team will be announced at the 2023 PATNET Conference and will work with the current editorial team over summer and fall of 2023 to facilitate a smooth transition.
